

*These stars are around to give Drake and Josh tips, or teach them something new. Touch a star and press the A Button to read what it has to say.*




## **SECURITY CAMERAS**

*Press switches to open doors. Some doors require you to press multiple switches, or to use something heavy to keep a switch pressed.*




## **LITTER**
