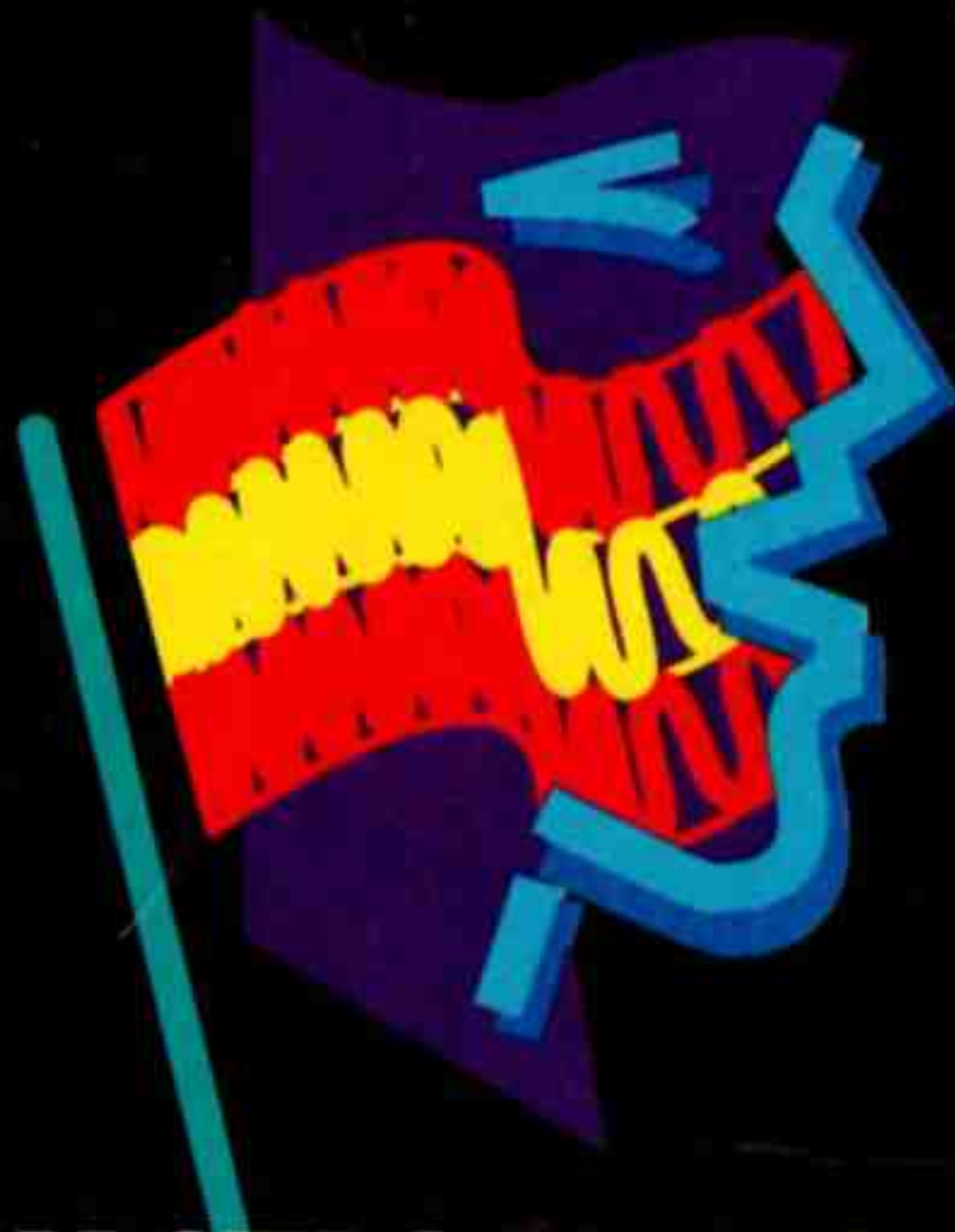

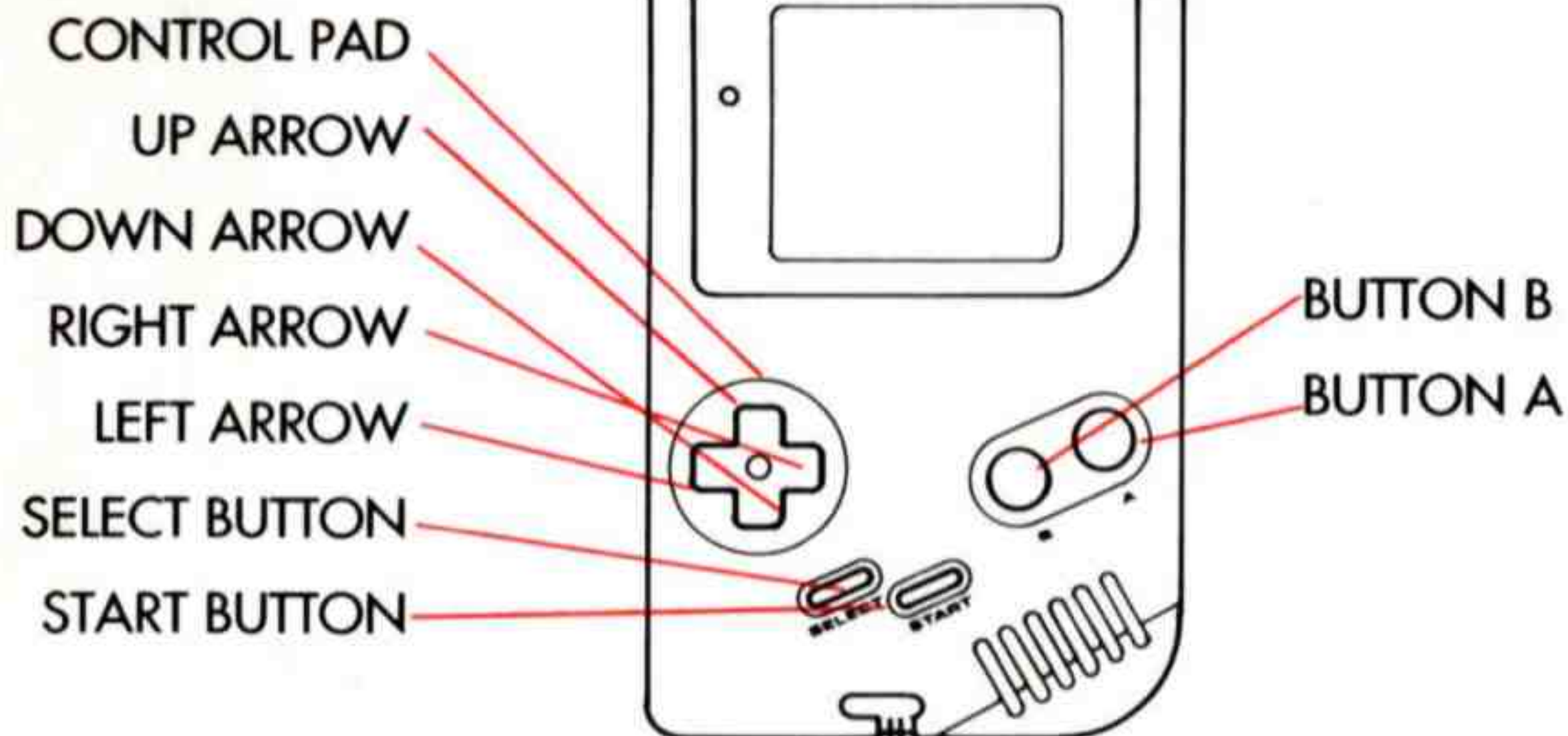

STARTING UP

Make sure your Game Boy power switch is turned OFF. Insert your InfoGenius Systems LANGUAGE TRANSLATOR cartridge, and then turn ON the power switch. "Nintendo®" will be displayed followed by the title screen and credits. If you wish to skip past the credits, you may do so by pressing either START or Button A.

CONTROLS



TO SELECT A LANGUAGE MODE — Press START or BUTTON A
TO MOVE THE CURSOR RIGHT OR LEFT — Press the RIGHT or LEFT ARROWS.
TO MOVE THE CURSOR UP OR DOWN — Press the UP or DOWN ARROWS.
TO LOCK IN A SELECTION FROM A MENU — Press START or BUTTON A.
TO LOCK IN A LETTER FROM THE KEYBOARD — Press BUTTON A.
TO ERASE A LETTER SELECTED FROM THE
KEYBOARD — Press BUTTON B.
TO TRANSLATE A WORD ENTERED FROM THE KEYBOARD — Press START.
TO RETURN TO KEYBOARD OR NUMERICAL KEYPAD AFTER TRANSLATION OR
CONVERSION — Press START or BUTTON A.
TO SCROLL THROUGH LISTS OF PHRASES — Press the UP or DOWN ARROWS.
TO RETURN TO PREVIOUS MENU SCREEN — Press SELECT.

THE CURSOR

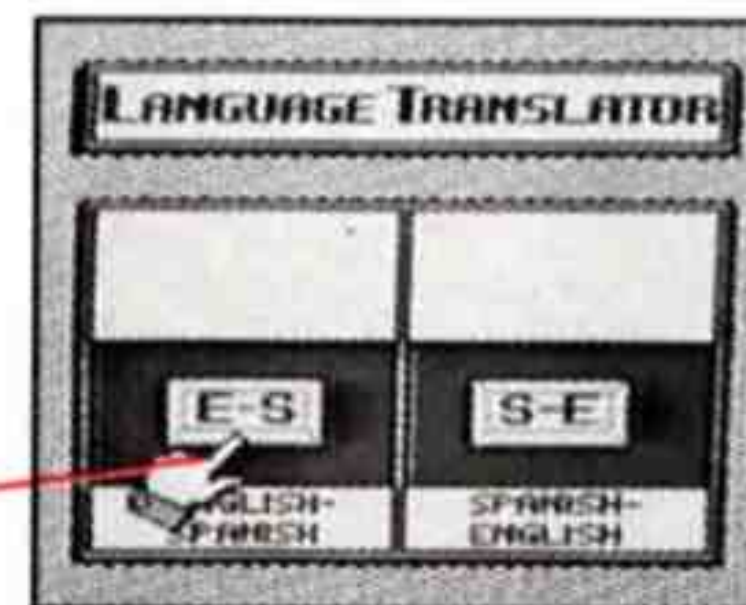
The cursor is represented on-screen by a hand icon with a pointing finger. You use the cursor to make keyboard and menu selections, and you control its movement with the ARROWS on the control pad.

LANGUAGE MODE

The InfoGenius LANGUAGE Translator will translate words and phrases from English to Spanish or from Spanish to English. When the Translator is started up, the cursor automatically points to the English-Spanish mode. Use the control pad ARROWS to move the cursor to either the English-Spanish mode or Spanish-English mode. When you've made your decision, press either START or BUTTON A to move to the next menu screen.

NOTE: The Language Mode you select here will affect the way you do currency and metric conversions. See the CONVERSIONS section on page 11 for more information.

THE MAIN MENU

After a language mode selection is entered, the Main Menu screen is displayed. Your mode preference now appears at the top of the screen; below it is the list of options. Use the cursor to highlight a particular option, then press START or BUTTON A to enter your selection.



WORDS

Choose the Words option from the Main Menu and a keyboard appears. Spell out the word you wish to translate by moving the cursor to a particular letter on the keyboard. Lock in that letter by pressing BUTTON A. Use BUTTON B to erase the last letter entered. When the word is completely spelled out, press START to begin the translation process. The word being translated will appear at the top of the screen, and a list of acceptable translations will appear below it.

NOTE: You will only be able to translate in the language mode you selected at the outset: English to Spanish or Spanish to English.

To return to the keyboard screen, press START or SELECT.
To return to the previous menu screen, press SELECT again.



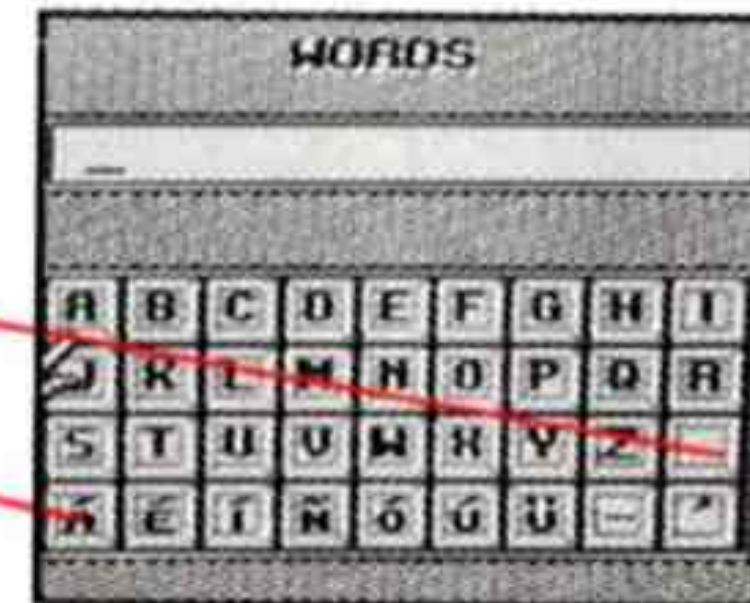
THE KEYBOARD

The Words keyboard includes letters A through Z, which can be entered in either one of the language modes. The following accented letters, however, can only be entered if you are working in the Spanish-English mode. They can be found on the bottom line of the keyboard:

Á, É, Í, Ñ, Ó, Ú, Ü,

The above letters will also appear on-screen if they are contained in a Spanish word that has been translated from English.

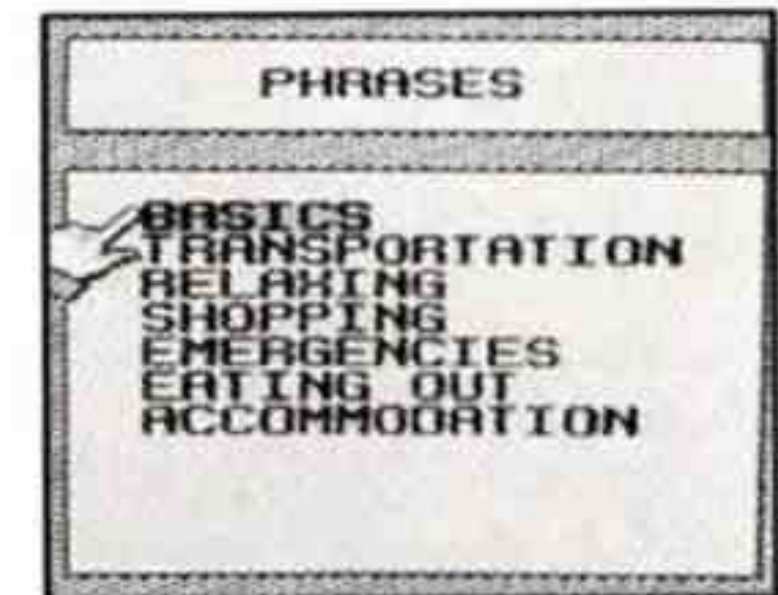
Space Key
Accented Letters



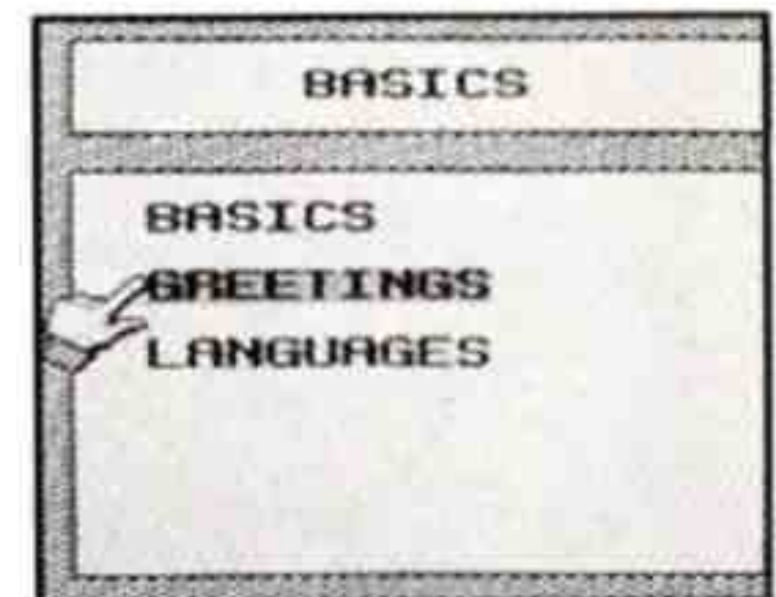
PHRASES

Choose the Phrase option from the Main Menu and the Phrase Menu screen appears.

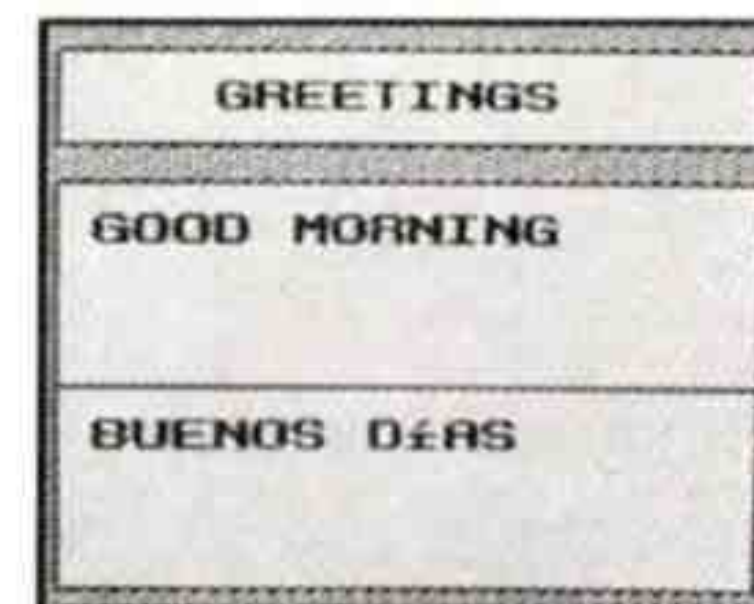
Choose a category with the cursor, which the control pad ARROWS move UP and DOWN. When the desired category is highlighted, press START or BUTTON A to lock it in.



The selected phrase category's menu screen will appear. Again, use the control pad ARROWS to move the cursor through these sub-categories. Your chosen phrase category will be displayed at the top of the screen. When the desired sub-category is highlighted, press START or BUTTON A to lock it in.



Now the phrases in your chosen sub-category will appear. The name of the sub-category is displayed at the top of the screen. Below it is the English translation of the first relevant phrase, and below that is the Spanish translation of the same phrase.



Press the control pad UP ARROW to scroll forward through the entire list of phrases in that particular sub-category. Press the control pad DOWN ARROW to scroll backward through the list.

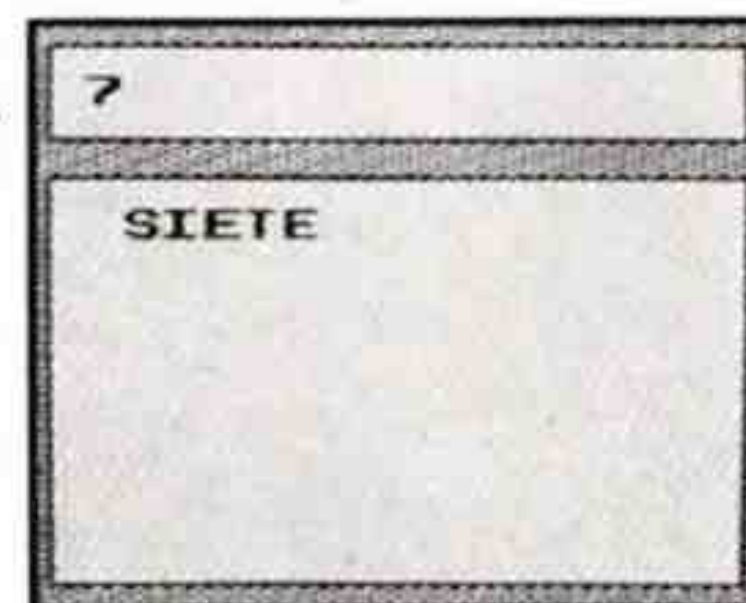
NOTE: The Phrases option will always function in the same way, regardless of the language mode you have chosen.

To return to the previous menu screen, press SELECT.

NUMBERS

English-Spanish Mode

This option functions similarly to the Words option, but acts as a short cut for translating numbers. Choose the Numbers option from the Main Menu. A numerical keypad appears. Enter the number you wish to translate by moving the cursor to the appropriate digits on the keypad. Lock in each digit by pressing BUTTON A. Use BUTTON B to erase the last digit entered. When all the digits have been entered, press START to begin the translation process. The number being translated will appear at the top of the screen, and its Spanish translation will appear below it.



To return to the keypad screen, press START or SELECT. To return to the previous menu screen, press SELECT again.

Spanish-English Mode

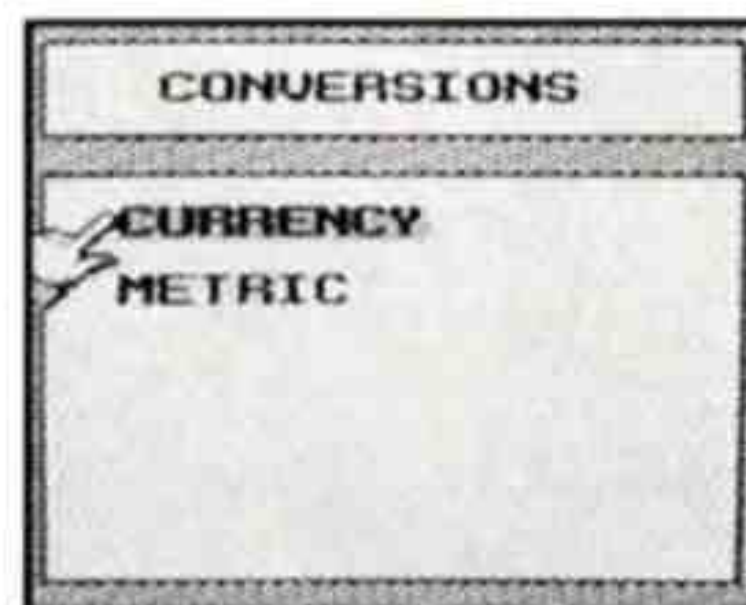
In this language mode, numbers will be translated into English. Follow the same instructions described above for the English-Spanish mode.

NOTE: You can also translate numbers in the Words option by spelling them out.

CONVERSIONS

The InfoGenius LANGUAGE TRANSLATOR contains a handy currency and metric converter, which should prove enormously valuable to the traveler. The currency converter will function with exchange rates for 10 Spanish-speaking countries; the metric converter handles miles/kilometers, miles per hour (m/h)/kilometers per hour (km/h), and Fahrenheit/Centigrade (Celsius) temperatures.

Choose the Conversions option from the Main Menu.
The Conversions Menu screen appears.



Choose a category with the cursor, which the control pad ARROWS move UP and DOWN. When the desired category is highlighted, press START or BUTTON A to lock it in.

CURRENCY

English-Spanish Mode

In this language mode, conversions will be made from dollars to foreign currency. If you've selected Currency from the Conversions Menu screen, the Currency Menu screen appears. A list of 10 Spanish-speaking countries is displayed. Choose a country with the cursor, using the UP and DOWN ARROWS. When the desired country is highlighted, press START or BUTTON A to lock it in.



Setting the Exchange Rate

Before you use the currency converter, you must first set current exchange rates. This procedure must be followed for each new TRANSLATOR session.

NOTE: When the Game Boy unit is turned off, the TRANSLATOR will no longer save a previously-set exchange rate. The Game Boy will save the exchange rates for all 10 countries during one session.

After you've selected a country, you will be prompted to enter the current exchange rate of that country's monetary unit to the U.S. dollar.

Use the numerical keypad to enter the exchange rate amount by moving the cursor to the appropriate digits on the keypad. Lock in each digit by pressing BUTTON A. Use BUTTON B to erase the last digit entered.

When all the digits of the exchange rate have been entered, press START.

Currency Conversion

After you've entered the exchange rates, you're ready to begin currency conversion. First, you'll be prompted to enter the U.S. dollar amount you wish to convert to its foreign currency equivalent. Use the numerical keypad and lock in each digit by pressing BUTTON A. Use BUTTON B to erase the last digit entered.



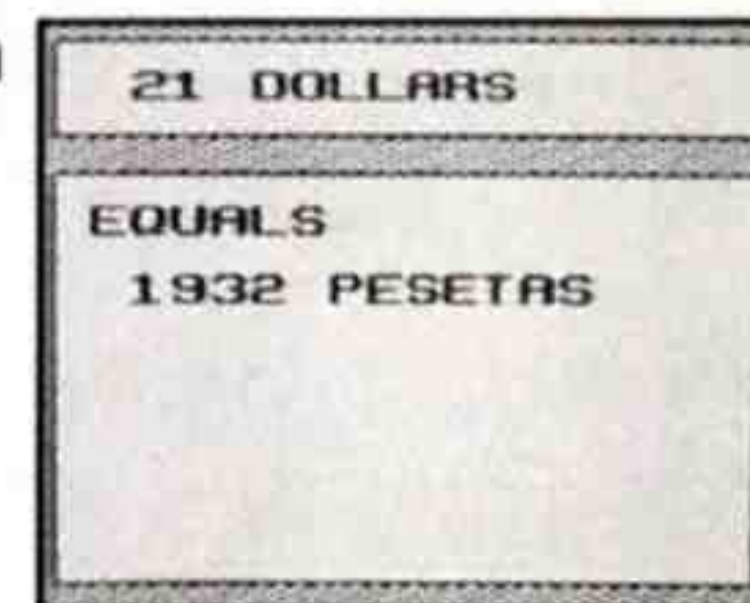
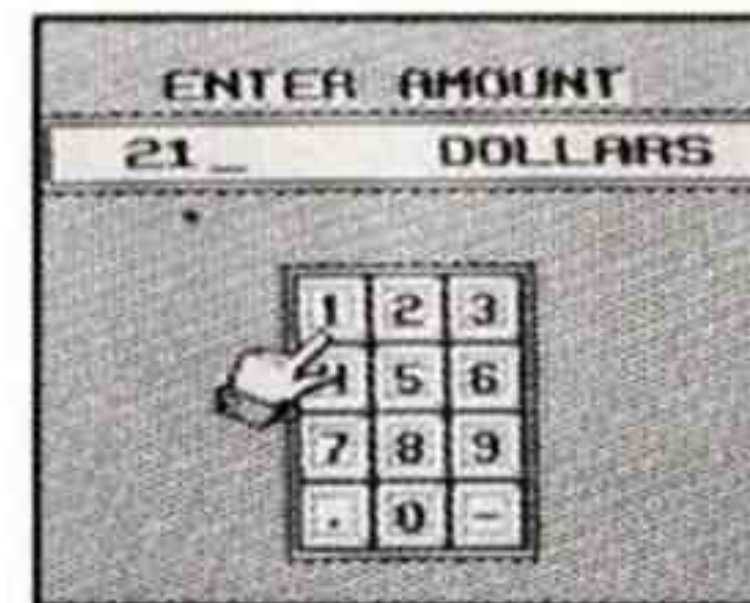
When all the digits of the amount have been entered, press START to begin the conversion process.

The amount being converted will appear at the top of the screen, and its foreign currency equivalent will appear below it.

To return to the keypad screen, press START or SELECT. To return to the currency entry screen press SELECT again. To return to the previous menu screen, press SELECT one more time.

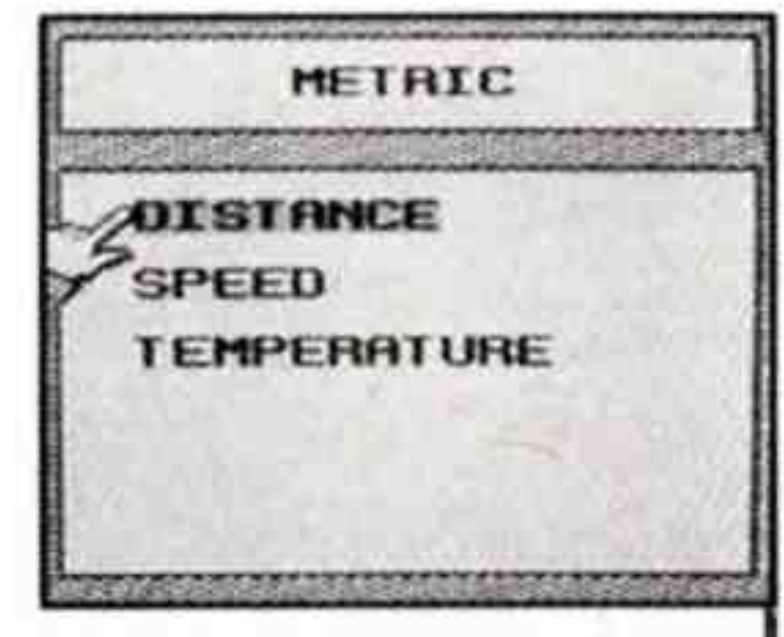
Spanish-English Mode

In this language mode, conversions will be made from foreign currency to dollars. Follow the same instructions described above for the English-Spanish mode.



METRIC

If you've selected Metric from the Conversions Menu screen, the Metric Menu screen appears. Select a metric conversion category with the cursor, using the UP and DOWN ARROWS. When the desired category is highlighted, press START or BUTTON A to lock it in.

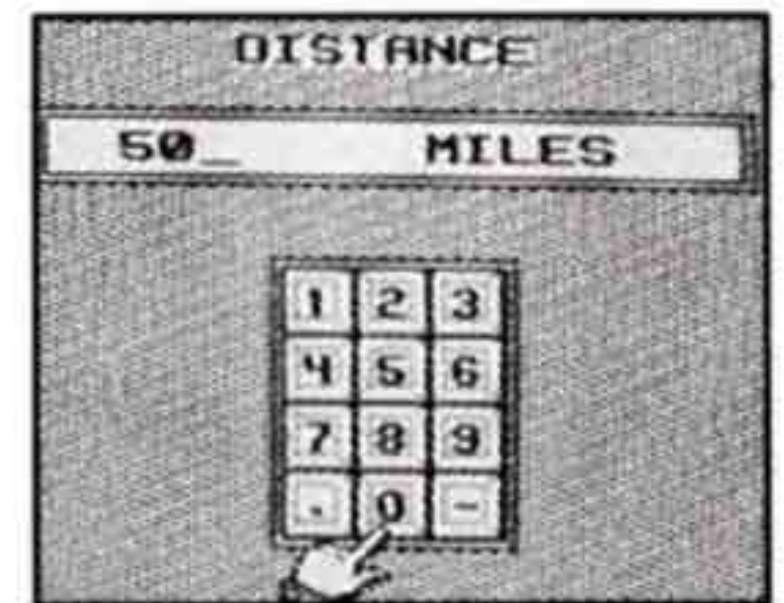


Distance

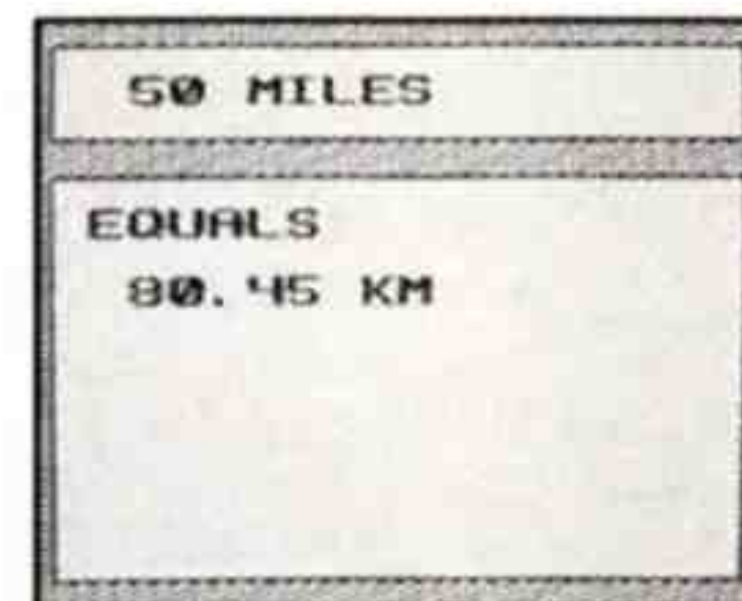
If you've selected Distance from the Metric Menu, the Distance keypad screen appears.

English-Spanish Mode

In this language mode, miles are converted to kilometers. Enter the number of miles you wish to convert by moving the cursor to the appropriate digits on the keypad. Lock in each digit by pressing BUTTON A. Use BUTTON B to erase the last digit entered.



When all the digits have been entered, press START to begin the conversion process. The number of miles will then appear at the top of the screen, and its kilometer equivalent will appear below it.



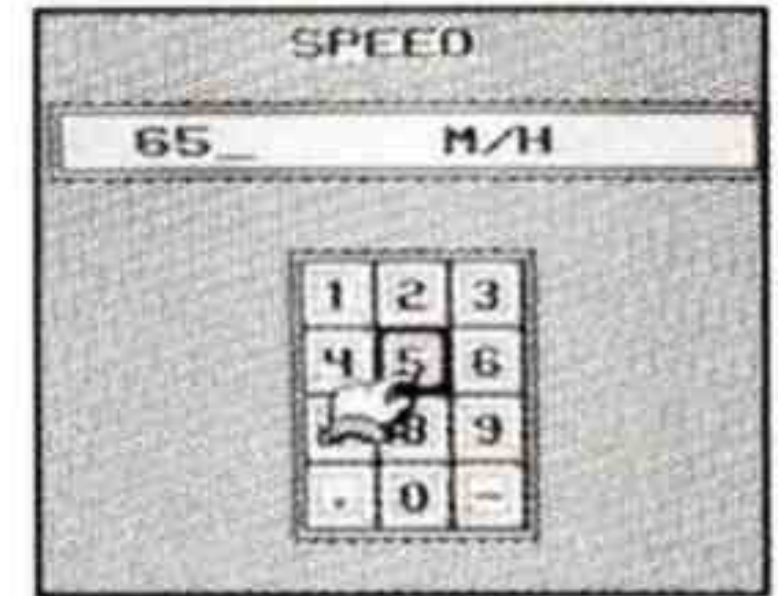
Spanish-English Mode

In this language mode, kilometers are converted to miles. Follow the same instructions described above for the English-Spanish mode.

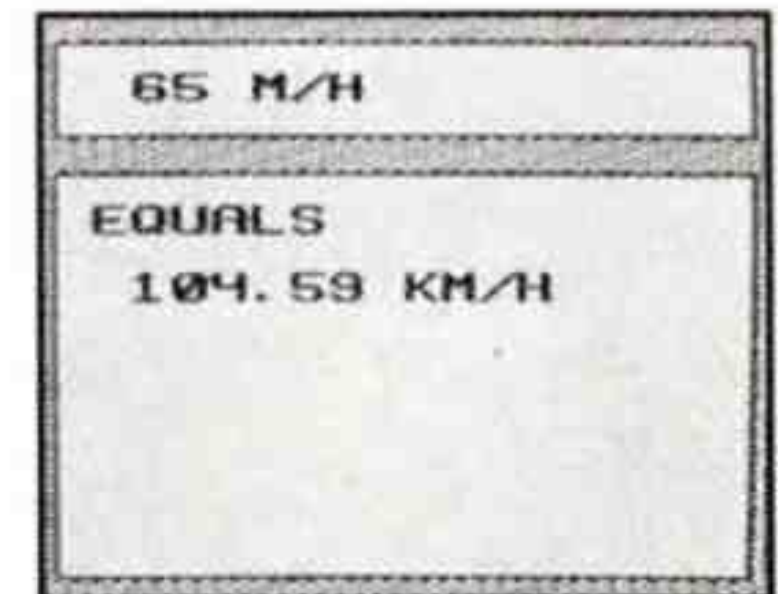
SPEED

English-Spanish Mode

In this language mode, miles per hour (m/h) are converted to kilometers per hour (km/h). Enter the m/h you wish to convert by moving the cursor to the appropriate digits on the keypad. Lock in each digit by pressing BUTTON A. Use BUTTON B to erase the last digit entered.



When all the digits have been entered, press START to begin the conversion process. The m/h will then appear at the top of the screen, and its km/h equivalent will appear below it.



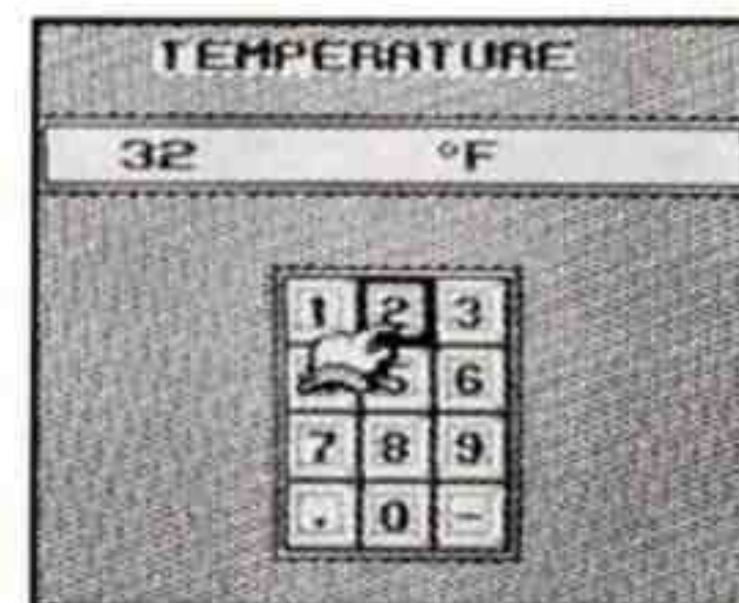
Spanish-English Mode

In this language mode, kilometers per hour (km/h) are converted to miles per hour (m/h). Follow the same instructions described above for the English-Spanish mode

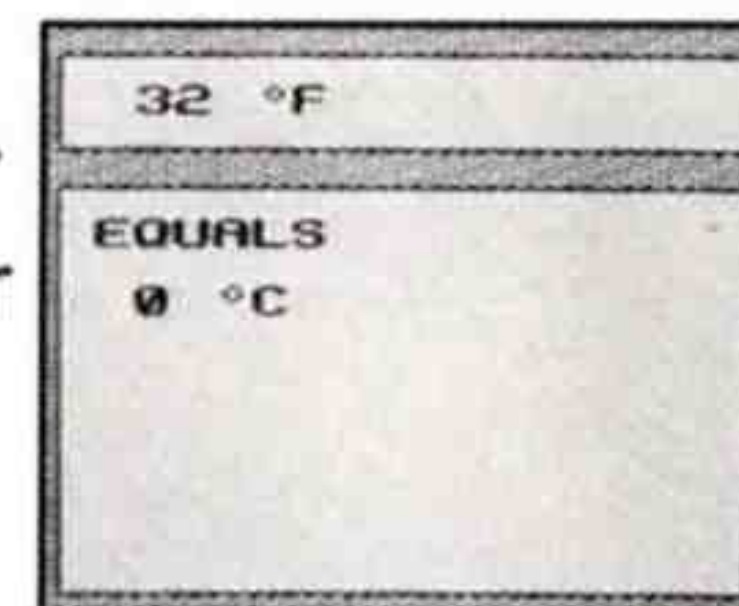
TEMPERATURE

English-Spanish Mode

In this language mode, Fahrenheit temperatures are converted to Centigrade (Celsius). Enter the Fahrenheit temperature you wish to convert by moving the cursor to the appropriate digits on the keypad. Lock in each digit by pressing BUTTON A. Use BUTTON B to erase the last digit entered.



When all the digits have been entered, press START to begin the conversion process. The Fahrenheit temperature will then appear at the top of the screen, and its Centigrade equivalent will appear below it.



Spanish-English Mode

In this language mode, Centigrade (Celsius) temperatures are converted to Fahrenheit. Follow the same instructions described above for the English-Spanish mode.

SAFETY TIPS

This is a high precision cartridge. Do not use or store it under conditions of extreme temperature, or subject it to rough handling or shock.

Do not disassemble the unit.

To avoid malfunction, do not touch the terminals or let them come in contact with water.

Do not wipe this equipment with volatile solvents such as thinner, benzene or alcohol.

Store the cartridge in its protective case when not in use.

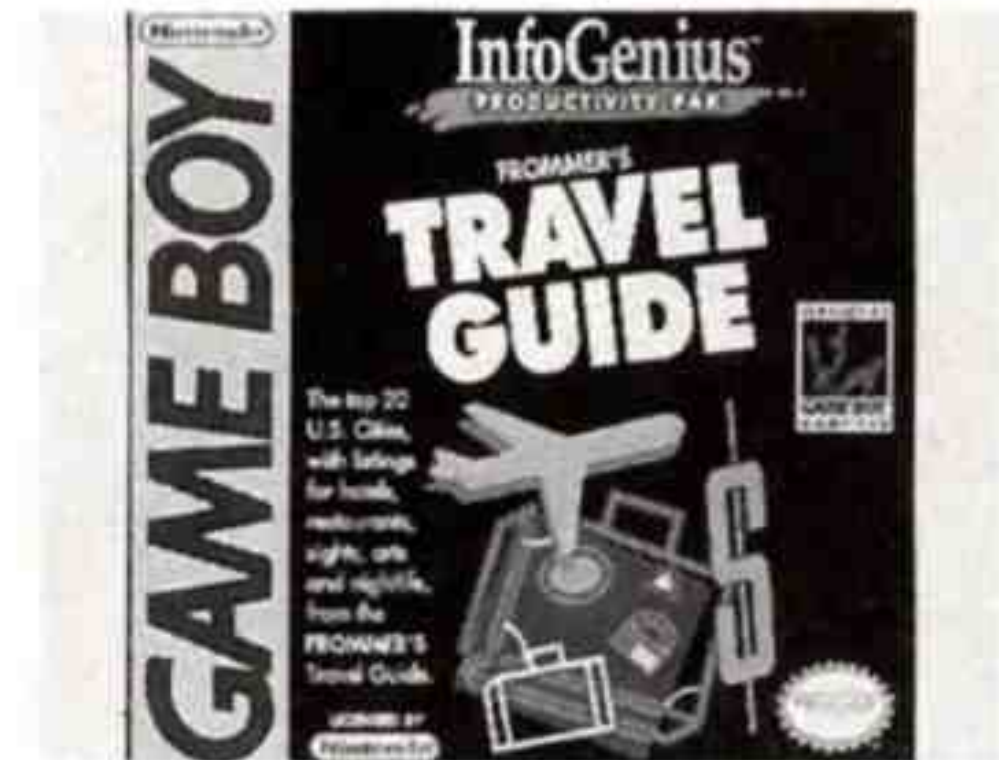

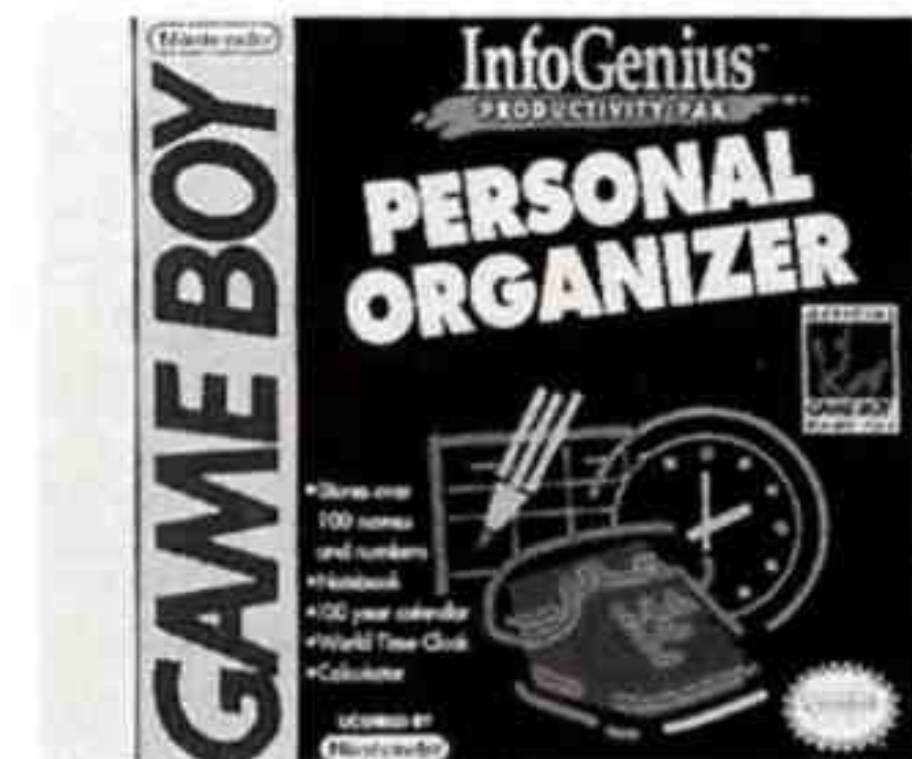
